

OIL PAINTING SUPPLY LIST with live links

Required Paint Colors

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Red Light
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Alizarin Crimson
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Phthalo Blue

I am adding Zinc White to the list. AND a [BRUSH CLEANER](#): or [SOAP BAR](#) (I recommend this bar, need a [container](#) to keep it from being messy)

I recommend finding an oil paint kit and using a coupon!

- Brushes specific to OIL painting
- Beginning with a medium-sized 4 or 6 round and a large and small flat are ideal.

As you learn more, you can expand your brush collection to various sizes and styles. Hog bristle, sable, or Taklon brushes work best.

For beginners, I suggest an assortment of Round, Flat, Bright, Filbert, Fan, and rigger brushes. <https://www.thesprucecrafts.com/an-introduction-to-art-paint-brushes-4086375>



- Large [Palette Paper](#). I suggest 9x12 or 12x16
- Pad of [canvas paper](#). I recommend the brand Arches.
- [Palette Knife](#), used to mix paints and paint with. [Flat razor](#) for cleaning hard palettes.
- Paper Towels & Rags

2 Jars with lids to hold solvent (best to be glass, or solvent-safe plastic). Save your salsa, jelly, baby food, pasta sauce jars, etc. These can save paints.

TIP: also a good idea to have a coffee mug or tall heavy container to hold up your brushes while you work.
